**620** Individuals served who regained stability (i.e., reliable transportation, housing, and employment)

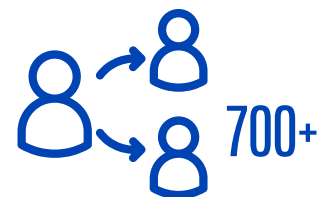
